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**APPLY** as a team of two or three who may include a community member, long-term knowledge holder or cultural specialist, and educator or youth group leader. At least one team member is required to enroll for a 3-credit 500-level course (cost \$100-\$150).

**SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS** receive travel, lodging and project planning support. Upon successful completion of the workshop, they receive GLOBE certification and monitoring supplies. Community teams will engage in Arctic and Earth STEM integrating GLOBE and NASA (SIGNs) project (NASA Award No. NNX16AC52A).
